

HF GROUP – THE CLUB SPARK AWARD COMPETITION TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The HF GROUP – CLUB PICK Competition is organised by Scottish Rugby Limited, trading as Glasgow Warriors.

When you enter this Competition, you agree to the following Terms and Conditions.

1. The Promoters

The Promoters of this Competition are:

- a) Scottish Rugby Limited trading as Glasgow Warriors, a company incorporated in Scotland with registered number SC132061 and having its registered office at Murrayfield, Edinburgh EH12 5PJ (“**Glasgow Warriors**”); and
- b) HF Group Limited, a company incorporated in Scotland with registered number SC316875 and having its registered office at 100 Albert Drive, Glasgow, Lanarkshire, G41 2SJ (“**HF Group**”);

together Glasgow Warriors and HF Group are the “**Promoters**”.

2. The Competition

- 2.1. These Terms and Conditions apply to the Competition running on Glasgow Warriors website [Home - Glasgow Warriors](#), and being promoted on, the Promoters’ official websites and social media channels (including but not limited to Facebook, Instagram, TikTok and X formerly known as Twitter) (“**the Competition**”).
- 2.2. To enter the Competition, a coach from a community Rugby Club must complete the electronic nomination form that can be found on <https://glasgowwarriors.org/hf-group-competition/>. The nomination form requires the coach completing it to demonstrate that their Rugby Club meets the specific values of Glasgow Warriors and HF Group as set out in the Competition information. When submitting the nomination form, it will require the coach to submit their name, email address, the name of the Rugby Club they represent and the county in which the Rugby Club is located. Any entries submitted to the Promoters in any other manner or medium will be disqualified from the Competition. Only one entry per Rugby Club is permitted.
- 2.3. The opening date for the Competition is Thursday 23 April 2026 at 09:00 BST. Nominations must comply with the conditions set out in conditions 2.2 and 3 and any nominations that do not comply (in the sole opinion of the Promoters) will be disqualified from the Competition.
- 2.4. The Competition will close on Friday 29 May 2026 at 17:00 BST (“**the Closing Date**”). Nominations received after the Closing Date will be automatically disqualified from the Competition.
- 2.5. The Promoters accept no responsibility for a nomination not successfully completed, lost, mislaid, damaged or delayed in transit, regardless of cause, including, for example, as a result of any equipment failure, technical fault or malfunction, systems, satellite, network, server, computer hardware or software failure of any kind.
- 2.6. Two members of staff from Glasgow Warriors shall carry out a sift of the nominations and will select one nomination to go onto the next stage (“**Glasgow Warriors Shortlist**”) and two members of staff from HF Group shall carry out a sift of the nominations and will select one nomination to go onto the next stage (“**HF Group Shortlist**”). The Promoters shall judge the nominations during their respective sifts on which nomination most closely meets the values of the Promoters.
- 2.7. The Glasgow Warriors Shortlist and the HF Group Shortlist shall be collated, and one winner shall be chosen by the Promoters. The decision of the Promoters is final.

- 2.9. By submitting a Competition nomination you are agreeing to (a) be bound by these Terms and Conditions; (b) to enter the Competition on behalf of your Rugby Club; (c) if your Rugby Club is the winner, to your Club's name and images of the Club and players being recorded and published for promotional purposes by the Promoters or its authorised representatives and to allow the Promoters to comply with its obligations set out at conditions 5.4 and 5.5; and (iv) if your Rugby Club is the winner, and any players under the age of 16 take up a Prize (as defined in condition 4 below), you confirm that you have obtained the prior written consent of such players' parent or guardian to their child being photographed or videoed when taking up the Prize.

3. Eligible Entrants

- 3.1. An eligible entrant is a Rugby Club who has been nominated to the Competition by a coach of that Rugby Club in accordance with condition 2.2.
- 3.2. The Competition is open to all Rugby Clubs in Scotland who can travel to Scotstoun Stadium to take up the Prize.
- 3.3. Rugby Clubs entering the Competition must be based in the Scotland.
- 3.4. No employee or immediate family of either Glasgow Warriors or HF Group who is a coach for a Rugby Club can enter their Rugby Club into the Competition.
- 3.5. In entering the Competition, the coach nominating the Rugby Club confirms that they are eligible to do so and that the Rugby Club is eligible to claim a Prize. The Promoters may require the coach nominating the Rugby Club to provide proof that the Rugby Club is eligible to enter the Competition.
- 3.6. The Promoters will not accept Competition nomination entries that are:
- (a) automatically generated by computer;
 - (b) completed by third parties or in bulk;
 - (c) illegible, have been altered, reconstructed, forged or tampered with;
 - (d) photocopies and not originals; or
 - (e) incomplete.

4. The Prize

- 4.1. One winning Rugby Club will receive the following **Prizes**, to be used during the 2026/2027 rugby season:
- 4.1.1. A 1 hour training session with a member of the Glasgow Warriors' coaching team for players of the winning Rugby Club such session being held at Scotstoun Stadium unless otherwise agreed; and
 - 4.1.2. A nutritional workshop hosted by a Glasgow Warriors' nutritionist for players of the winning Rugby Club such session being held at Scotstoun Stadium unless otherwise agreed; and
 - 4.1.3. An opportunity for 50 players of the winning Rugby Club, aged between 10 and 18, to be guard of honour at a Glasgow Warriors Men's home game together with 50 tickets to the game; and
 - 4.1.4. Access to one (1) table of ten (10) people for players of the Rugby Club at one (1) Glasgow Warriors mens home game, including hospitality; and
 - 4.1.5. The opportunity for players of the winning Rugby Club, to have a meet and greet with one (1) Glasgow Warriors player, to be chosen by Glasgow Warriors at Scotstoun Stadium such session being held at Scotstoun Stadium.

- 4.2. Each of the Prizes are subject to a maximum number of attendees which will be discussed with the winning Rugby Club when they are notified that they are the winner of the Competition.
- 4.3. The Prize does not include the cost of travel to and from the Scotstoun Stadium, food and drink, spending money, tax or personal expenses. Any other costs incurred in addition to those set out above and that are incidental to the fulfilment of the Prize are the responsibility of the winning Rugby Club.
- 4.4. This Prize is not transferable or exchangeable and cannot be taken as cash.
- 4.5. The Prize is supplied by Glasgow Warriors.
- 4.6. Glasgow Warriors reserve the right to replace the Prize with an alternative prize of equal or higher value if circumstances beyond the Promoter's control make it necessary to do so.
- 4.7. The decision of the Promoters regarding any aspect of the Competition is final and binding and no correspondence will be entered into about it.

5. Notification of winning nomination entries

- 5.1. The winning Rugby Club will be notified by email (using details provided at entry) the week commencing 15th June 2026 that their Rugby Club is the winner. The Prize or instructions of how to receive the Prize will be sent to the winning Rugby Club by the Promoters within (seven) 7 days of being notified that their Rugby Club is the winner.
- 5.2. If the winning Rugby Club does not respond to the Promoters within seven (7) days of being notified by the Promoters or if the winning Rugby Club is unable to accept the Prize due to ineligibility, the Prize in its entirety will be withdrawn and the Promoters will be entitled to select another winner in accordance with the process set out at conditions 2.6 and 2.7.
- 5.3. The Prize may not be claimed by a third party on behalf of a winner, other than a winning Rugby Club claiming a Prize on behalf of their players.
- 5.4. The Promoters must either publish or make available information that indicates that a valid award took place. To comply with this obligation Glasgow Warriors will send the surname and county of the winning Rugby Club to anyone who writes to Glasgow Warriors at the address set out in condition 1 (enclosing a self-addressed envelope) within one month after the Closing Date of the Competition.
- 5.5. If the winning Rugby Club objects to either or both of their Club's name and county being published or made available, please contact Glasgow Warriors at community@glasgowwarriors.org. In such circumstances, the Promoters will not provide the information to members of the public, but must still provide the information and winning entry to the Advertising Standards Authority ("ASA") on request by the ASA, to comply with our legal obligation to do so.

6. Data protection

- 6.1. As part of submitting an entry to the Competition, the coach submitting the nomination is required to submit certain personal details, including their name and email address, the name of the Rugby Club they represent and the county within which the Rugby Club is situated.
- 6.2. The legal basis for which the Promoters will collect personal data in respect of Competition are (i) its legitimate interest of administering the Competition, and (ii) to comply with its legal obligations in respect of competitions.
- 6.3. The Promoters will use the personal data of the coach completing the nomination form as follows:

- 6.3.1. to contact them as the representative for the winning Rugby Club and to send the Prize to them;
 - 6.3.2. to contact an alternative winner and to send the Prize to them if a winner cannot be contacted within a reasonable time; and
 - 6.3.3. to comply with the legal obligation to provide the winner's name and county in response to requests for this information from third parties, subject to conditions 5.4 and 5.5.
- 6.4. The Promoters will comply with the Data Protection Act 2018 and the UK General Data Protection Regulation when collecting and otherwise processing personal data in connection with this Competition. The Promoters will use personal details that the coach provides to the Promoters in line with Glasgow Warrior's [Privacy & Cookies Policy - Glasgow Warriors](#).

7. General

- 7.1. These Terms and Conditions and this Competition are governed by the laws of Scotland. By entering into this Competition, each coach from a Rugby Club who submits a nomination agrees to submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the Scottish courts.
- 7.2. Each coach from a Rugby Club who submits a nomination is deemed to have accepted and agreed to be bound by these Terms and Conditions upon entry to the Competition.
- 7.3. The Promoters reserve the right to disqualify any nominations that breach these Terms and Conditions or any nominations that, in the sole opinion of the Promoters, are in any way obscene, violent, abusive, discriminatory, defamatory, fraudulent or otherwise unlawful or would damage the reputation of the Promoters. Where the Promoters disqualifies any nomination in accordance with this condition 7.3, the Promoters shall remove any affected nominations from the Competition.
- 7.4. The Promoters reserve the right to cancel this Competition at any time. The Promoters reserve the right to amend these Terms and Conditions without notice by posting changes to the website [Home - Glasgow Warriors](#). The Promoters will only notify the coaches from Rugby Clubs who have submitted a nomination of changes if required to do so by law.
- 7.5. Insofar as is permitted by law, the Promoters, its agents or distributors will not in any circumstances be responsible or liable to compensate any nominated Rugby Club or accept any liability for any loss, damage, personal injury or death occurring as a result of entering the Competition or the winning Rugby Club taking up the Prize except where it is caused by the negligence of the Promoters or that of its employees, agents or distributors. Your statutory rights are not affected.
